

Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) Requirements 2011 - 2012

The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) is a general education pattern that will fulfill all lower-division general education requirements at all California State University (CSU) campuses and most University of California (UC) campuses / majors. It is also accepted by some private / independent or out of state universities. IGETC is usually recommended for students who intend to transfer to a UC campus, or who are not yet sure of their intended transfer university. Completion of the IGETC pattern is not an admission requirement for transfer to most UC or CSU campuses, nor is it the only way to fulfill the lower division GE requirements of a UC or CSU campus prior to transfer.

For assistance in determining the most appropriate general education pattern, consult a counselor.

AREA 1 – ENGLISH COMMUNICATION (CSU – one each from groups A,B,C) (UC – two courses, one from groups A and B). Minimum 3 semester units/4-5 quarter units for each group.

1A ENGLISH COMPOSITION: English 101 or 105

1B CRITICAL THINKING-ENGLISH COMPOSITION: English 205 or Philosophy 205

1C ORAL COMMUNICATION (CSU Requirement Only): Communication Studies 103 or 160

**CSU United States History, Constitution and American Ideals
(CSU Requirement Only)**

The California State University, before awarding a degree, requires students to complete courses or examinations that address: 1) The historical development of American institutions and ideals (**Area US-1**), and 2) The Constitution of the United States and the operation of representative democratic government under that Constitution (**Area US-2**), and 3) The process of California state and local government (**Area US-3**)

This requirement may be fulfilled prior to transfer by completing a combination of the courses listed below that satisfies all three areas of the requirement. Courses used to fulfill this requirement may not also be used in IGETC. Students, who have completed equivalent courses outside the State of California, must complete a course from Area US-3.
