

2011- 2012 UCSD CURRICULAR SUMMARY

We have published the 2011-2012 major-prep articulation agreements on ASSIST for all 114 community colleges. The following are major and curriculum changes in the ASSIST articulation agreements for the 2011-2012 academic year.

New Courses for Fall 2011:

Major Name Change:

Literature: Spanish and Latin American Literature

Changes in Majors:

- Biology: Human Biology B.S. and Physiology and Neuroscience B.S. now requires BILD 2*
- Chemistry and Biochemistry: Chemistry/Earth Sciences B.S. and Environmental Chemistry B.A. – Discontinued*
- Economics: Joint Major in Mathematics and Economics is now a B.S.*
- ECE: Computer Engineering B.S. – No longer requires Chemistry 6A*
- CSE: Computer Science B.S. and B.A. have additional course requirements: Physics 2A-2B or Chem 6A-6B or BILD1-2.*
- CSE: Computer Engineering B.S. – Physics 2D is no longer required*
- Cognitive Science B.S. degrees all require Math 20A series. Math 11 & 11L is no longer an option. CSE 8A-8AL-8B or CSE 11 has been added to all the majors.*
- Environmental Systems/Ecology, Behavior, and Evolution B.S. - Requires BILD 3, but strongly recommends BILD 1*
- Environmental Systems/Environmental Chemistry B.S and Environmental Systems/Earth Sciences B.S. – Math 20A series and Physics 2A-2B-2C is now required*
- Latin American Studies B.A. – The language requirement may be taken at the community college that is equivalent to UCSD's LTSP 2C (or above) or LTSP 50A (or above). Articulation of these LTSP courses have been include in this major.*
