The Third Bundle



The third bundle consisted of nine freshman and only one sophomore. And early on, the Lady Olympians had their share of growing pains. There is no doubt that it took this group some time to get a feel for the college game, but once they did, they showed that they were one of the most competitive teams in the state of California.

The Lady Olympians ended the season 4-21. And although this was only one more win than last year's squad, don't be fooled by the numbers according to Head Coach, Michael Hootner. "There was no comparison statistically," said Coach Hootner. "We averaged five more points per game, 10 less turnovers, shot a higher percentage from the floor, and had more assists and steals. The conference was the most competitive in the history of the Pacific Coast Athletic Conference (PCAC) and we played a stronger schedule than last year," concluded Coach Hootner.

The Olympians were led in scoring by sophomore, Annessa Jamison (9 ppg). Freshmen La Queshia Donald and Shelby Watson both averaged 8 ppg. Watson was the leading rebounder averaging six rebounds per contest. Watson also was the best shooter field goal percentage-wise as she shot 42% from the field.

The team was involved in two fundraisers this year for disaster relief in Haiti and Breast Cancer Awareness week.

The Men's and Women's teams worked collaboratively to help raise awareness and money for quake victims in Haiti. Head Men's Coach, Ed Helscher, and Coach Hootner both coached games without shoes on, joining several thousand coaches nationwide in this joint effort as a part of the National Association of Basketball Coaches and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association.

During Think Pink Week, Coach Hootner's squad along with other several thousand college teams and coaches nationwide, wore pink shoelaces, black and pink shirts, and played with an official Think Pink leather basketball to raise awareness and money for breast cancer awareness. The money was then donated to the V-Foundation and the Kay Yow Foundation for cancer research.

"This was the deepest and hardest working team I've had in my three years," said Coach Hootner. "They laid the foundation for all future teams on what we expect on and off the court, in the classroom, in the weight room, and in the community. I'm very proud of this bundle," concluded Coach Hootner.
