

## PELL GRANT

A portion of your Pell Grant **may** be available for use in the bookstore if you are enrolled in 6 or more units. The amount used at the bookstore is then subtracted from your award and the remaining amount is divided into two payments. All checks are mailed to the address on file in the Admission's Office. The post office **does not** forward checks.

You do not need to be full-time to receive a Pell Grant, but your award will be adjusted based on your enrollment status on the dates indicated below. **If you were awarded after the enrollment status date below, your disbursement date becomes your enrollment status date.**

## LOANS

If you are a first year student, due to Federal regulations, your loan check will not be disbursed until at least **30 days** after the start of the semester.

One-semester loans are disbursed in two payments.

## CAL GRANT B, C, AND FSEOG

You must be enrolled in at least six units in order to receive Cal Grant B, C, or FSEOG funds.

## STUDENTS AWARDED AFTER THE SCHEDULED PAYMENT DATES

If you are awarded after the scheduled payment dates stated above, your disbursement will be calculated based on your current enrollment status at the time the award is made. Your disbursement will be mailed or Direct Deposited approximately one week after you have received your award notification. Your loan check will be mailed or Direct Deposited approximately one week after you have signed the promissory note.

## DROPPING CLASSES &/or FAILING TO ATTEND LATE START CLASSES

If you drop all of your classes, or you do not attend at least one day of your late start class, you will be notified by mail of any amount of federal funds that you must repay. See the financial aid bulletin for detailed information.
